

“Sowing the Seeds of the last days.”

It's been quite a while since I've posted about the times in which we are now living in, but there is a sense of urgency to inform those who are willing to listen. In the coming days and weeks, I'm going to attempt to lay out in short simple terms where we are and how it affects us. It will be called “Sowing the Seeds of the last days.” It will not be judgmental or just opinion but a word to bring some clarity to the times in which we find ourselves. We did not choose to live in these times but if you believe in a divine creator then it's clear that we have been chosen for just such a time as this. With all of our life experiences and ups and downs the lessons we have learned have brought us to this place. It will take a few posts to lay out the scenario that is now in view but I'm hoping you'll stick with me and together we can begin to understand His plan for the sake of our children and our children's children. Eyes open and expecting.

Part 1 Introduction

So in order to properly layout a clearer picture of these troubled times in which we find ourselves in, for this first post we will need to establish the basic framework that God gives us and how that is communicated and understood. Much like a 1000-piece jigsaw puzzle that we used to put together on our dining room tables years ago, in order to begin to build it we needed 2 basic elements. First and foremost, we needed the box cover picture so we could see the **big picture** of what we were building and secondly, we needed the frame or outside square pieces to establish the framework of the puzzle. In order to do this let's look at how the big picture is communicated. In John 1:1- 3 it states in the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

So the first thing we establish is Jesus the creator of ALL things was the initiator of this scenario. The 66 books of the Bible were written by over 40 authors over the course of 1500 or so years, many of the authors never having met one another yet all the themes and topics of the stories and stated history are consistent. The Bible will be our source. Given the above verses let's look at the consistency of Paul in the book of Colossians that tells us all things were made by Him **and for Him**, things in Heaven and things on Earth. He created the seen and the unseen world. The Jewish ruler Nicodemus came to Jesus at night and inquired about his (Jesus') ministry and was told that there is an unseen realm that exists, but you will need your Spirit awakened in order to see it. Nicodemus couldn't grasp the concept of an unseen realm. Jesus pointed out to him that you know that the wind is present, but you can't see it why is it so hard for you to believe in the unseen realm? Given there is more here than meets the eye so to speak let's first establish the players (in order of creation) and their roles in this seen and unseen scenario.

The players

First- God The creator Father, Son and Holy Spirit. **Let US (being the trinity) make man in our image.**

Second- The celestial beings, the angelic hosts. The book of Job states that the angelic hosts rejoiced when God created the cosmos. So, they were there before the creation of the sun, moon and stars.

Third - Mankind Adam and Eve and the human race who were placed in this creation and given dominion over it.

These three characters are the players in this scenario and as we will see, make the storyline for us to follow. Let's remember when we pick up the story (history lesson) in genesis Satan has already rebelled and is in his fallen state in the garden.

So, many will ask the question why didn't God just squash the rebellion right there and make a wonderful world without evil in it? I ask you; do you think God had to put the tree of knowledge of good and evil in the garden? No, he didn't. Why did he?

Do you think he knew man would eat of it? Yes of course he did. In order to give man, the choice of living with or without fellowship with God He needed to present him with a choice and in establishing evil he allowed one of the highest ranking of the angelic hosts to show the depths of depravity that our choices would bring.

Let's remember when man was created God had just dealt with a third of the celestial hosts rebellion. Let's also remember that all things were created FOR Him and by Him. Eze. 28 says of Satan: ...The workmanship of your timbrels and pipes was prepared for you on the day you were created.

notice verse 15 says the day Satan was **created**. So, if all things were created for God and by God knowing he would fall why was Satan created?

Here we begin the crux of the story. In the beginning (Genesis) We, mankind were created to fellowship with God. In the end of the story, we see the end result of this:

Rev. 21 v3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He (God) will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and **God himself will be with them** as their God.

He wanted to fellowship with people that, after experiencing good and evil, chose to be with Him.

That is the final goal, (fellowship together, God and mankind) and by tracing these players through history we will now see why knowing the big picture and the entire story is so important to the days in which we find ourselves.

The groundwork is laid, let's begin.

Part 2

The Seed War

Now that the ground work is laid we will pick up where we left off in post one. We start in the garden where Adam and Eve follow the enticing option of being like god and break the one rule that was given to them and how God deals with it.

In Gen. 3:15 we see the seed plot for **The entire plan for mankind**. It is very easy to just read over this and miss the importance of this verse.

15 I will put enmity between you and the woman,
and between **your offspring and her offspring**.
he shall bruise your head,
and you shall bruise his heel.”

Here God gives his sentence for the trespass of the evil one and lays out the plan that locks mankind and Satan into a timeline that will bring this cosmic war to its conclusion.

I want to remind everyone of the players in the unseen world, and if you can stay with me you will see throughout this Bible journey how this relates to the world we are in and the timeline we are on.

The war begins: most of us read through the biblical stories and relate it's principles to our everyday lives and there is much to gain from that. But if we step back to see the big picture we begin to see the picture on the box top cover of the puzzle (from post 1).

God gives Satan the first clue on how his destruction will come in the above verse. His demise will come from the seed of Eve!

Now as we trace that narrative through the history of the Bible it begins to manifest within stories, the prophets, the nation of Israel and all the way to the days in which we live. Let's look at some of the progression that has unfolded. Note that we are looking at the unseen world and its effects on the world we're living in.

We pick up the narrative in Genesis and the only thing Satan knows at this point is God will use the seed of Eve to destroy him. Is it any wonder that the first act of murder was that of unrighteous Cain killing the righteous seed of Eve? Coincidence? I think not. Satan went to war with the righteous seed of Eve. Every time God reveals more about where the seed that will destroy Satan will come from it is attacked by Satanic forces. When many years transpired Satan again goes after the seed. But he doesn't have anymore information as to where it will come from. So He tries to pollute the entire seed pool.

Notice Gen. 6 and the flood of Noah. Gen. 6:1,2

1 ¶ When man began to multiply on the face of the land and daughters were born to them,

2 the sons of God saw that the daughters of man were attractive. And they took as their wives any they chose

The term here sons of God in Hebrew means a direct creation of God. The sons and daughters of Adam and Eve were not direct creations of God, they came from Adam and Eve. These were fallen angels that came to earth and procreated with human women. Verse 4 clarifies it.

4 The Nephilim were on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the sons of God came in to the daughters of man and they bore children to them. These were the mighty men who were of old, the men of renown.

Nephilim is a cross breed of angels and humans.

If you have never seen this before you are probably shocked, but it's clearly stated and we shall see what was at stake here.

What plan would Satan have in this maneuver? Let's remember that the seed of the woman must be a pure human seed. In order for Jesus (the pure seed) to save mankind and destroy Satan he must be a pure human seed. If the gene pool is corrupted with any seed other than 100% human genes, he could not be the 2nd Adam.

How does God deal with this intrusion? Gen. Verses 8,9

8 But Noah found favor in the eyes of the LORD.

9 ¶ These are the generations of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, blameless in his generation. Noah walked with God

So why Noah? Was he a sinless human? No let's note verse 9, it says he was Blameless in his generation.

The King James reads perfect in his generation. Note that this reads like the angels came down and very soon after God acted. The truth is The Nephilim were procreating with humans for what some estimate over 1000 years. So, the gene pool of humanity was heavily corrupted. What a demonic plan! If Satan can corrupt the human gene pool to the point that there are no pure humans left, He wins! But Noah. **Perfect in his generation means he still had perfect uncorrupted human genes.** Thus, the flood of Noah and the unblemished seed of Eve is preserved. We will see in the next installment that this theme progresses through the biblical narrative. As God begins to reveal where the seed will come from Satan attacks it. Is it any wonder that when Moses was born there was a decree to kill the children? But God had Moses sent in a basket down the river and Moses was raised in Pharaoh's house. You have to love the irony of Gods plan. Do you think it is a coincidence that after God had chosen Abraham and his descendants became the nation of Israel that as they arrived at the promise land, Satan had giants (Nephilim) there? Or when Jesus was a baby, the decree went out to kill all the babies there? It was all the seed war, and it was Satan after the seed of Eve.

In our next installment we will see the relevance of the seed war and how it affects our lives today.

Part 3

Greetings All and welcome back to Sowing the Seeds of the Last Days. This is Part 3, and we will begin to see in this narrative the effects of this war on humanity and as we do it will start to answer some of the questions that arise from the tragic outcome of the war that rages daily on humanity. The senseless behaviors and strange actions that some people have unknowingly committed that are the result of the cosmic struggle we find ourselves in.

In order to get proper perspective on these behaviors we must keep in mind that the source of these struggles are not from this world but rather the unseen forces that are at war with humanity. Paul wrote of this in Ephesians chapter 6 when he spoke of the daily battle, we are all fighting. And how to live daily in this war and teach our children and our children's children to equip them for the battle we find ourselves in.

The Whole Armor of God

10 ¶ Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might.

11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil.

12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places

He said that we are not wrestling against flesh and blood but against powers and principalities wicked spirits in the heavenly places. In other words, Satan and his angelic followers are hell bent on making you act and look like you are not a follower of Jesus (The triumphant seed of Eve.)

If you're a believer in Jesus and have the spiritual birth that Jesus spoke of to Nicodemus from my previous installment, you may be asking the question "if I am a Christian and my faith is sealed until the day of redemption why would evil forces bother with me?" The answer is simple but extremely serious, you my friend are an ambassador for Christ and everything you do and say reflects on other people's perception of Jesus. Your life either draws people to Christ or turns them away. You see once you are aware of the big picture and the titanic struggle you are in you begin to see how your life affects others and why demonic forces want to destroy your life and your testimony for Christ.

Which brings us to the times in which we find ourselves. Let's be honest, if you truly believe in the God of the Bible than surely you don't think he would just drop us off on this planet and say, see you later I hope you enjoy yourselves? No if you seek Him, you will find Him and you will find out that he has told us all that we need and has let us know what will take

place and how to position ourselves for it. Let's leave this installment with this thought, in the book of Revelation Jesus dictated 7 letters to his church. 7 Report cards if you will, that forewarned us of the mindset that would prevail in the final days of his church. It is not a pretty picture, but you must confess that it is a description of a group of believers that are unaware or not interested in the spiritual world around them and have become very comfortable with sin and the good life. He says the following:

15 ¶ "I know your works: you are neither cold nor hot. Would that you were either cold or hot!

16 So, because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth.

17 For you say, I am rich, I have prospered, and I need nothing, not realizing that you are wretched, pitiable, poor, blind, and naked

Lukewarm clearly means that we have become complacent and are not interested in living for Christ. He comments that we think we are doing fine, and we don't need anything but from God's perspective we are poor, blind and naked. We don't think we are in a fight with demonic spirits, and we don't want to bother with anything of that nature. You see the big picture shows us that whether we believe it or not, whether we participate in it or not we are in it and accountable for our decisions and actions and how we live and teach our children to live will be our testimony to the world. Next time we will wrap up our conversation and show how Gods plan for mankind is in its final stages in culture, politics world events modern society and technology and what we can do to walk out our lives as God would have us too. Sowing the seeds of the last days Post 4

Greetings to all, as I mentioned last time in this final episode, we will sum up how this unseen world affects the world in which we now live in and how God has given us history in advance to prepare us in this final generation for what is now beginning to show itself in the world in which we live. Let's set the final scene in the unseen world. As we mentioned earlier Satan was always after the seed of the woman that was going to crush him as God had told him in the garden after he deceived Adam and Eve. But Satan had no idea that when he killed the seed, that would be the thing that destroyed him. Let's pick it up in 1 Cor. 2:7,8 where Paul is explaining to the church that Jesus' death was the act that defeated Satan, and it was a mystery to him as well as all the satanic princes and heavenly demonic powers, let's read it:

7 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, the hidden *wisdom which* God ordained before the ages for our glory,

8 which none of the rulers of this age knew; for had they known, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

So these verses show us that if Satan and his cohorts would have known that crucifying Jesus was what would bring their defeat, they never would have crucified him. You see this is why knowing about the unseen world and the battle that they are waging is so important for us and our children. We have to teach our children that although demonic powers will try to sway you, they are already defeated, and they can do nothing unless you give them permission. The sin nature we were born into has been nailed to the cross and we must exercise that power. Notice what Paul says in Col. 2:15:

13 And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses,

14 having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.

15 Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.

You see if we don't live in that place of understanding, the demonic forces of this world will deceive you into thinking you're under some kind of control that they tricked you into. These are vain imaginations or ungodly thought patterns that we must rise above and teach our children to rise above. Paul again in 2 Cor. 10:5 tells us how to live this way;

5 casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,

You see we need to live for Christ not just for us but for our children and humanity itself. We must take every thought captive and make it line up with Gods word.

So, let's end this article with some clear understanding of where we are and why it is so important. In the book of Joel God proclaims that when Israel returns to their land then that is the season when God will finalize his judgment on the nations.

1 ¶ “For behold, in those days and at that time,
When I bring back the captives of Judah and Jerusalem,
2 I will also gather all nations,
And bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat;
And I will enter into judgment with them there
On account of My people, My heritage Israel,
Whom they have scattered among the nations;
They have also divided up My land.

Let's remember there is still an enemy that wants to prove Gods word is not true. Since Jesus defeated him, his only hope is to stop the plan of God. That is why the Jewish nation has been his target since the cross. Rome scattered them to the 4 corners of the earth trying to remove them from history so Gods plan could not be fulfilled. Hitler tried to wipe them from existence in order to stop Gods plan but here we are with the nation of Israel back in their land and the final prophecies of the Bible about to be fulfilled. Let's also note that when the

book of revelation was written regarding each person having a mark and no one being able to buy or sell without it, who could have known that someone would be able to have the power to control everyone's life and finances? Welcome Ai, digital currency and the ability to shut down people's banks and know where they are and what they are doing 24/7. Indeed, we are living in the season of the end.
